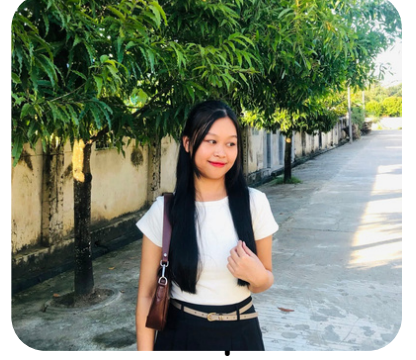

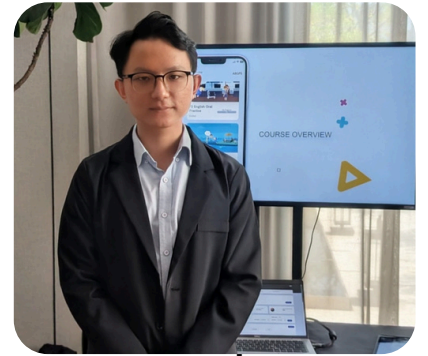

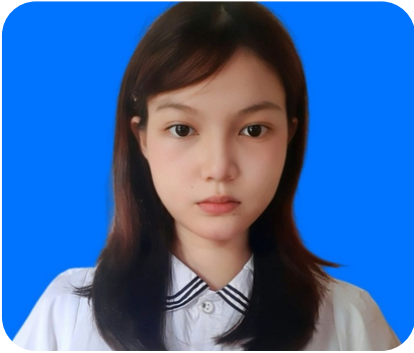

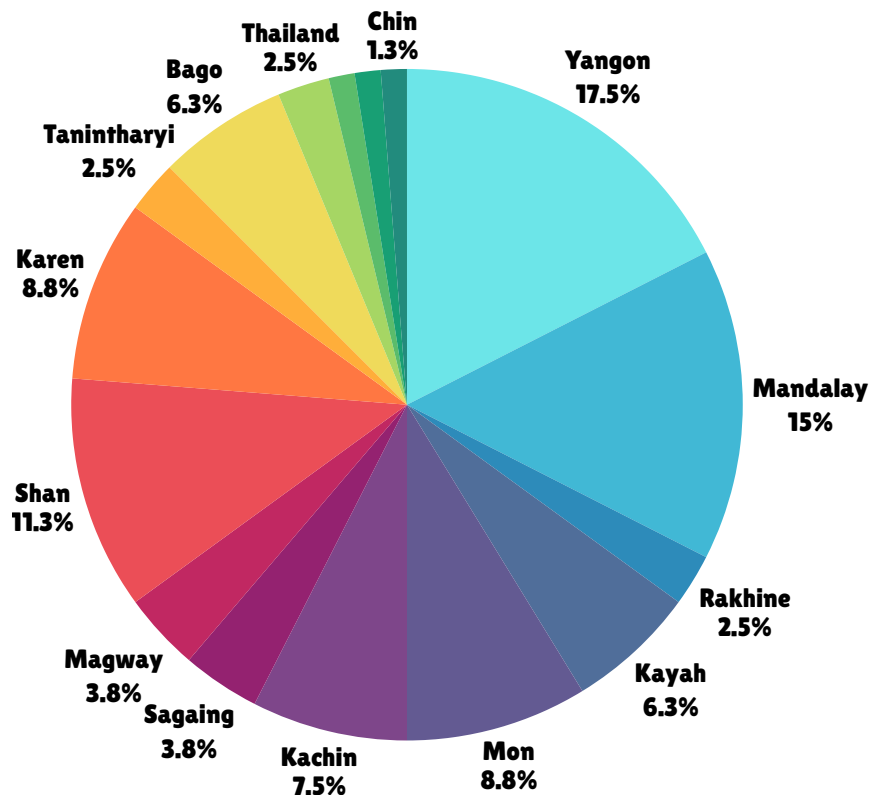

SELECTED APPLICANTS DEMOGRAPHIC (80 APPLICANTS)

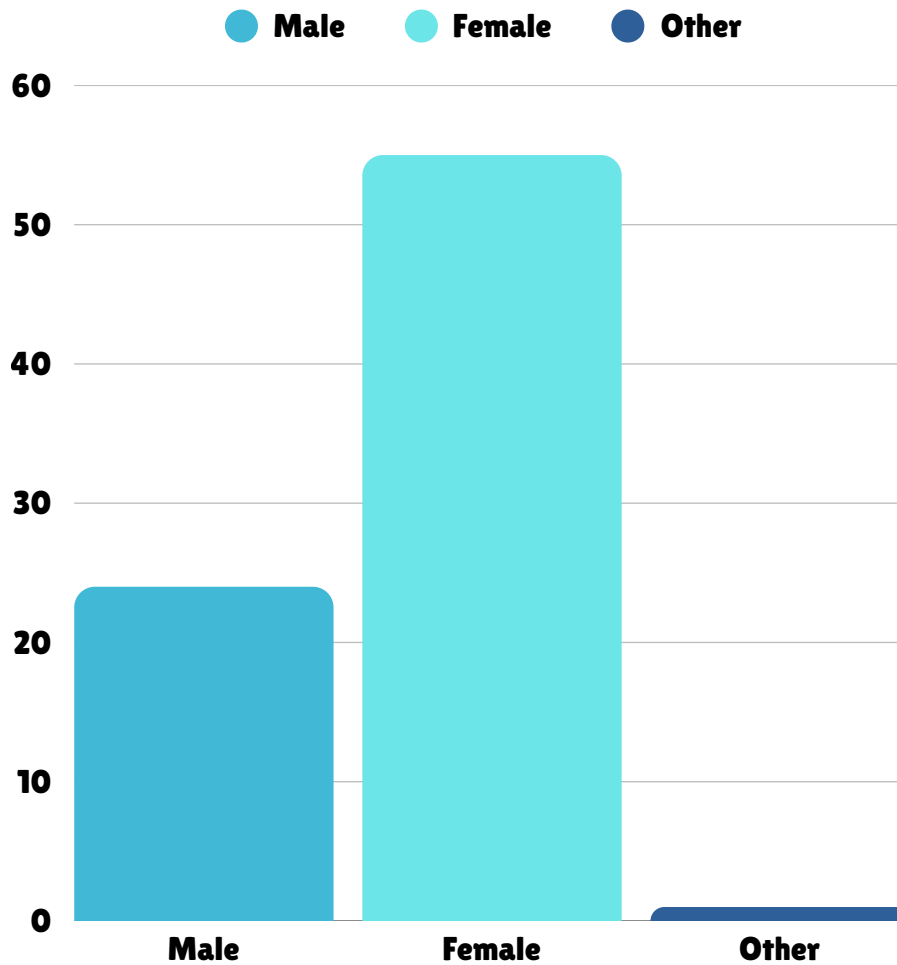
We have received a total of 467 applications. Among them, 80 students were finally selected for our **Scholarship Bootcamp II**.



This pie chart shows the percentage of participants from different states and regions. Each slice represents one region and its share of the total.

Key Observations:

- **Yangon (17.5%)** has the largest share.
- **Mandalay (15%)** follows as the second highest.
- **Shan (11.3%)** represents a significant portion of participants.
- **Karen (8.8%)** and **Mon (8.8%)** have equal proportions.
- **Kachin (7.5%)** also has a notable share.
- **Kayah (6.3%)** and **Bago (6.3%)** have the same percentage.
- **Sagaing (3.8%)** and **Magway (3.8%)** share equal distributions.
- **Rakhine (2.5%)**, **Tanintharyi (2.5%)**, and **Thailand (2.5%)** have smaller but equal shares.
- **Chin (1.3%)** has the smallest proportion among all regions.

Each bar represents the number of participants in each gender group.

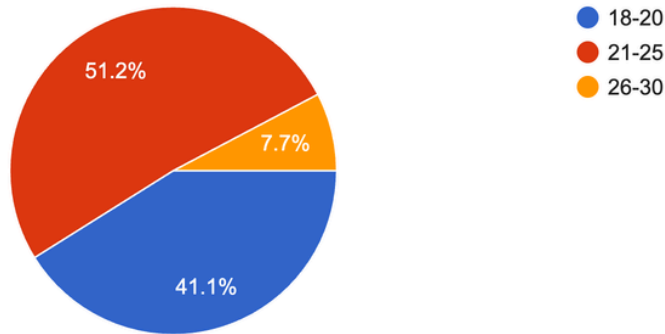
Key Observations:

APPLICANT DEMOGRAPHIC (467 APPLICANTS)

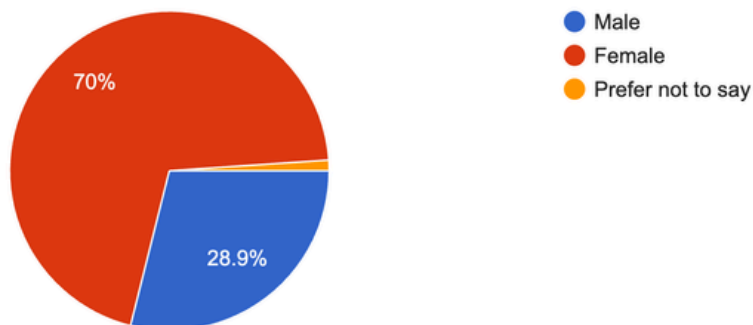
Age

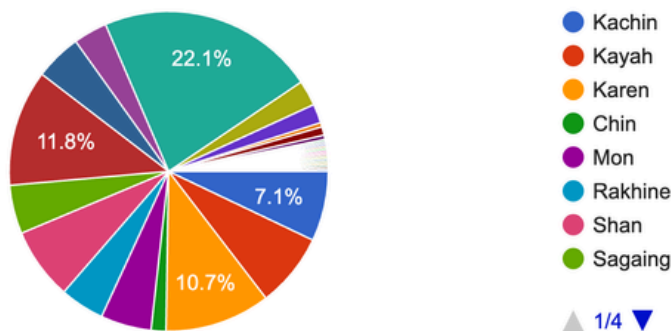
Gender

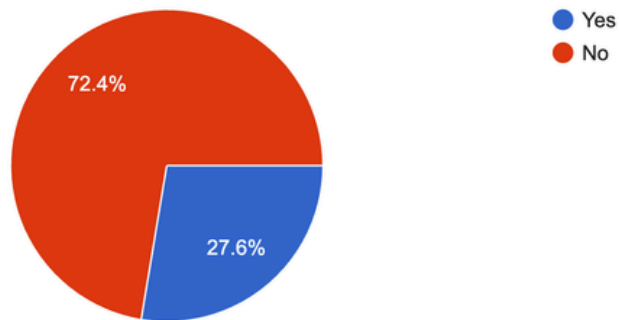
Region and State

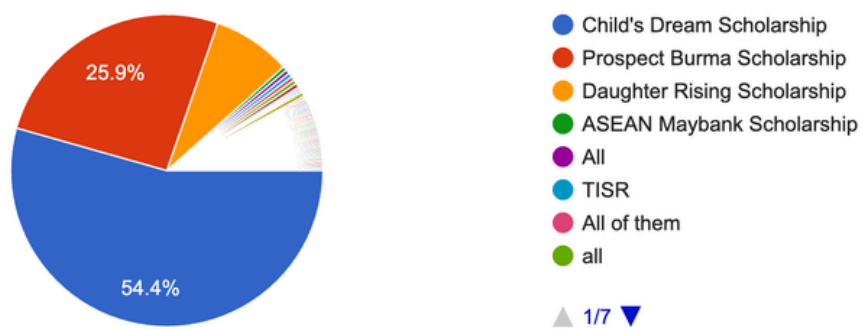
Have you applied for any scholarships before for undergraduate?

CONCLUSIONS ON SCHOLARSHIP BOOTCAMP II APPLICATIONS

1. Majority are First-Time Applicants

- Since **72.4% have never applied** for a scholarship before, the bootcamp should focus on **step-by-step guidance** to help applicants understand the process, requirements, and best practices.

2. Strong Female Representation

- With **70% of applicants being female**, this indicates a high interest from women in pursuing further education through scholarships. Programs could include mentorship and networking opportunities specifically for female applicants.

3. Diverse Age Group, Mostly Young Adults

- The majority (51.2%) are aged **21-25**, followed by **41.1% aged 18-20**. This suggests most applicants are either **undergraduates or recent graduates**. The bootcamp should cater to their needs, such as **essay writing, recommendation letters, and interview preparation**.

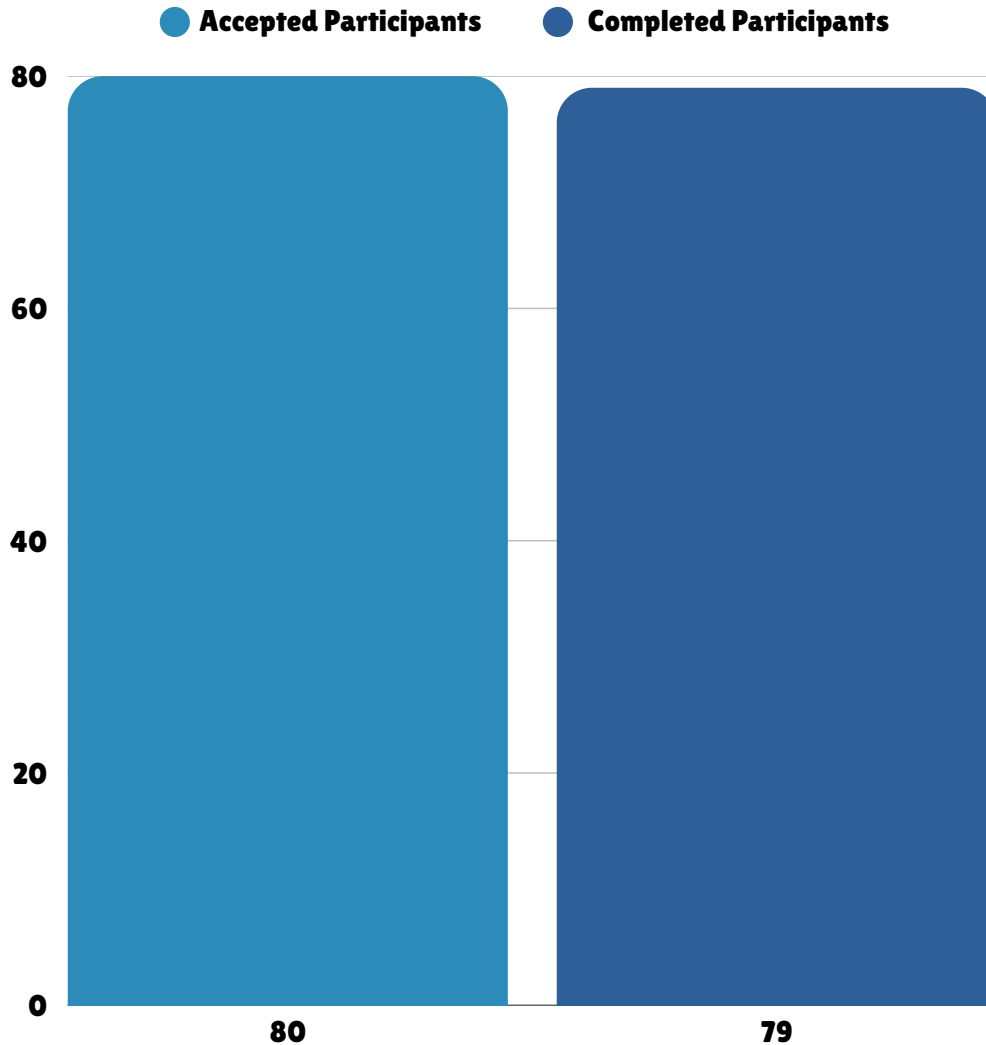
4. High Interest in Multiple Scholarships

- About **54.4%** want to apply for the Child's Dream Scholarship, while **25.9%** are interested in the Prospect Burma Scholarship. This suggests applicants are eager to **increase their chances** of securing funding, and the bootcamp should offer guidance on tailoring applications for these specific major providers.

5. Significant Regional Diversity

- Applicants are spread across various regions, with notable participation from Sagaing (**22.1%**), Shan (**11.8%**), and Magway (**10.7%**). This highlights the need for the bootcamp to be accessible to students from diverse geographical backgrounds, possibly through digital resources or flexible scheduling.

REACHED IMPACT



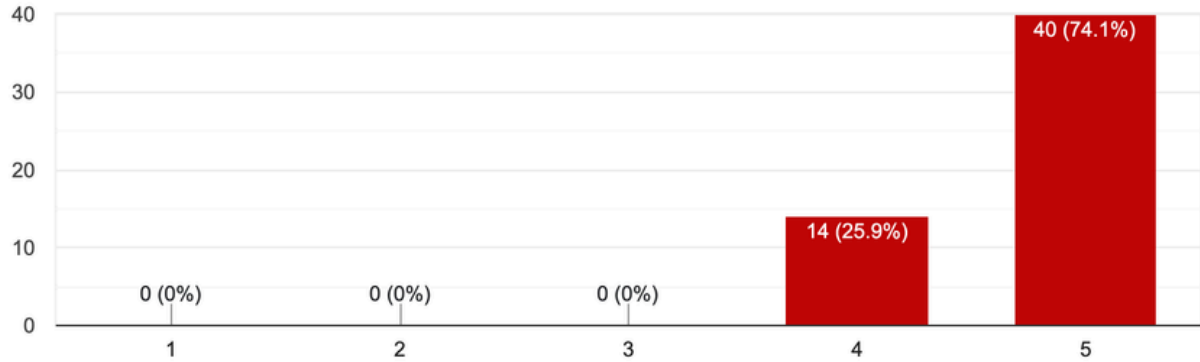
In **Scholarship Bootcamp II**, one participant dropped out at the beginning of the program due to personal issues and internet problems. However, we immediately replaced this participant with someone from the waiting list.

Out of 80 participants, 79 successfully completed all the program requirements. Only one student did not finish the consultation session due to professional responsibilities and a tight schedule.

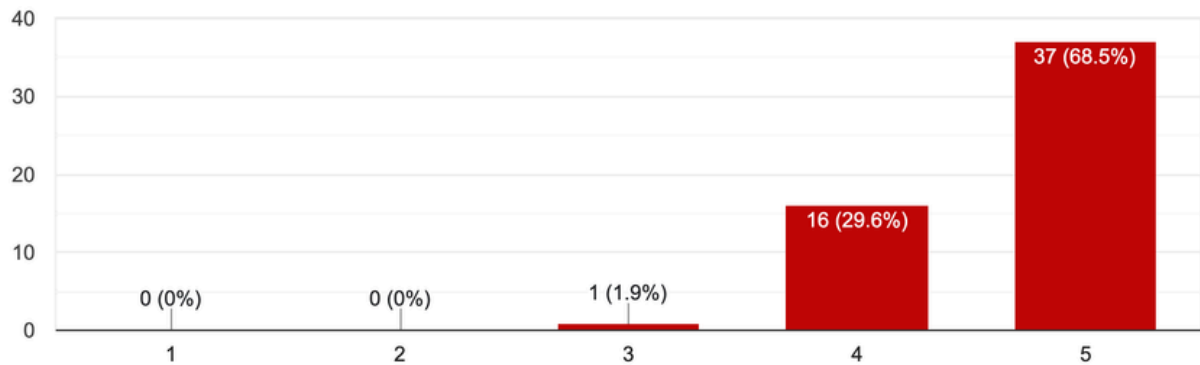
Relevance of the training content.

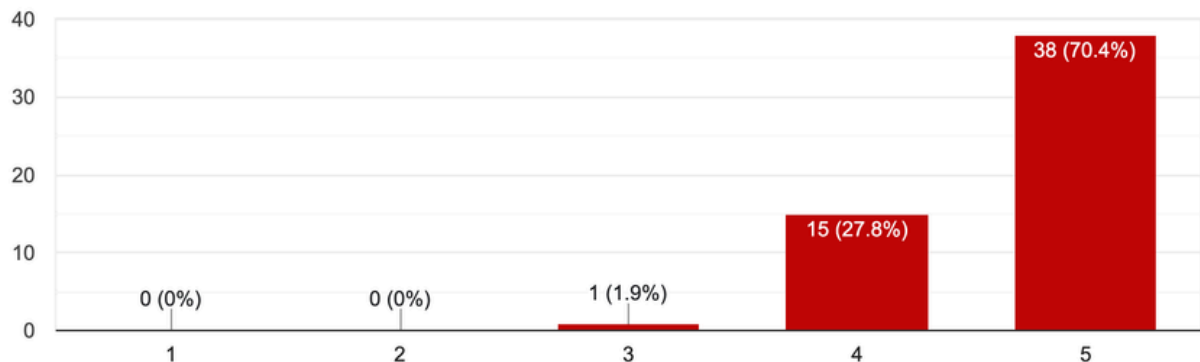
Quality of the trainers/speakers

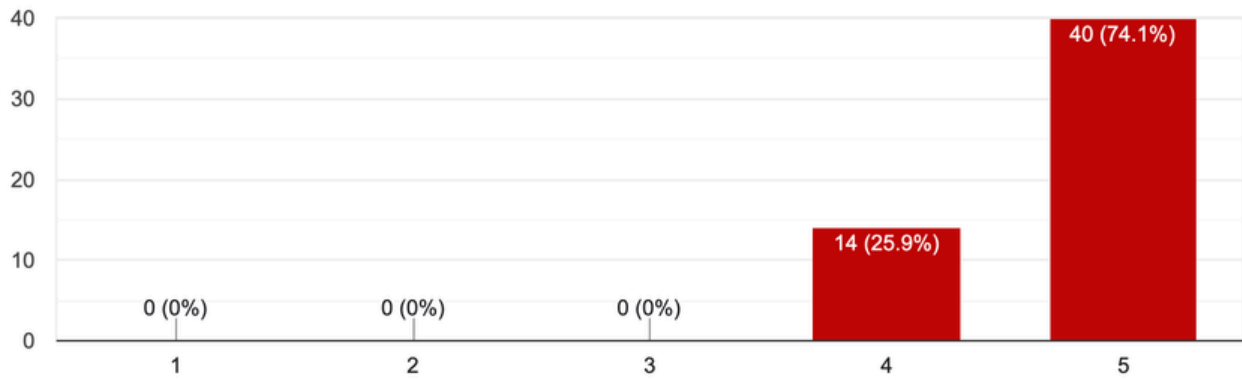
Organization and structure of the bootcamp

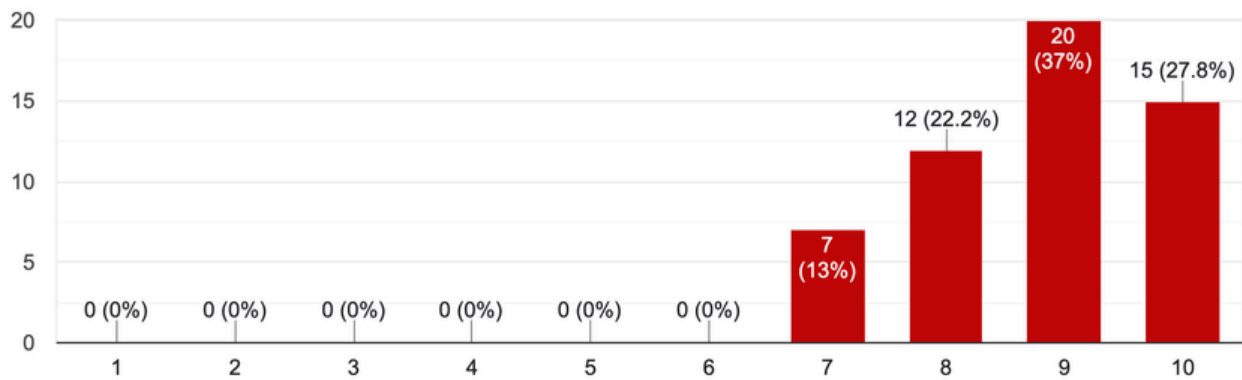
Overall satisfaction with the training

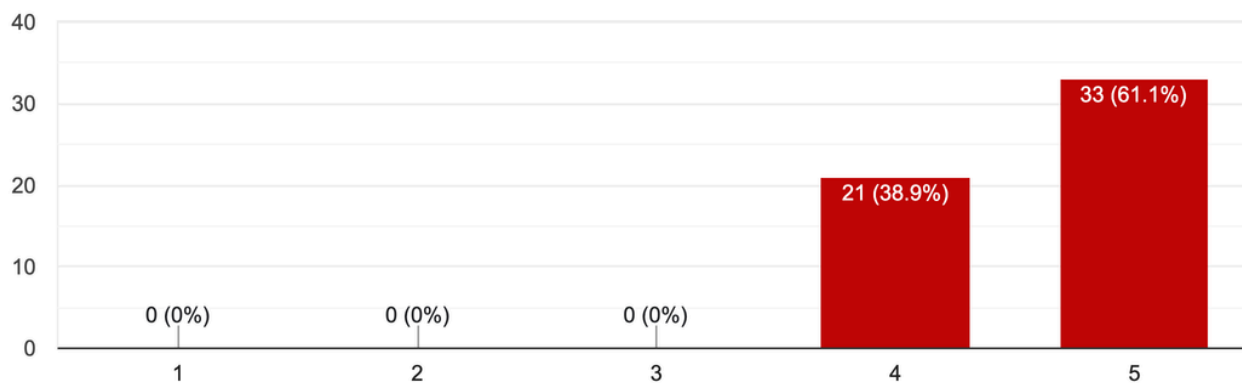
Did the training meet your expectations?

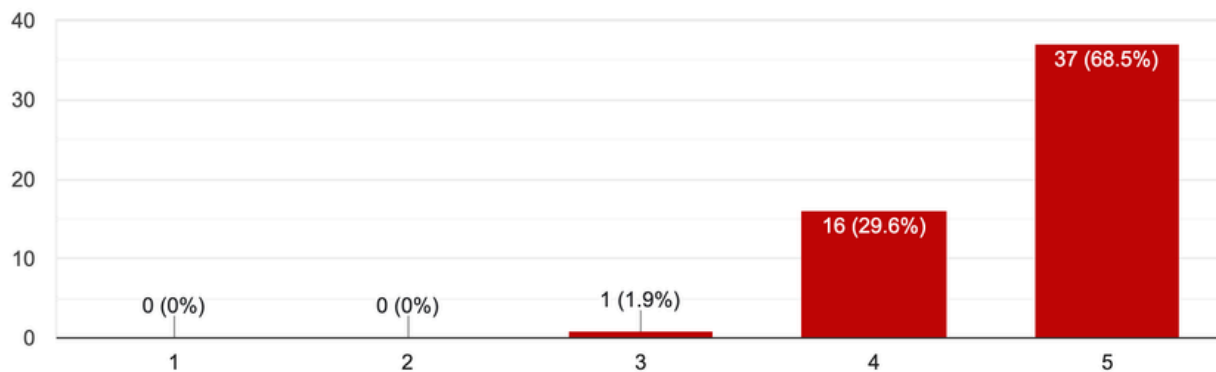
How would you rate the trainers' knowledge and delivery?

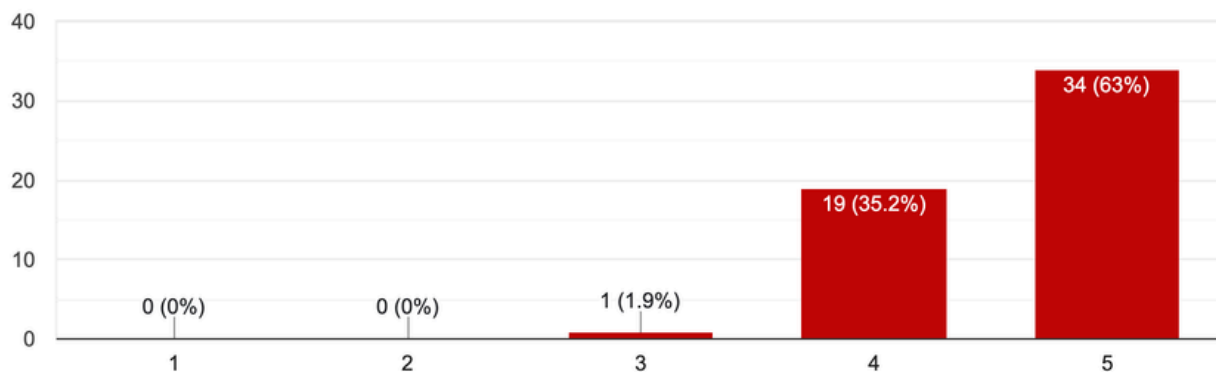
Were the trainers engaging and responsive to questions?

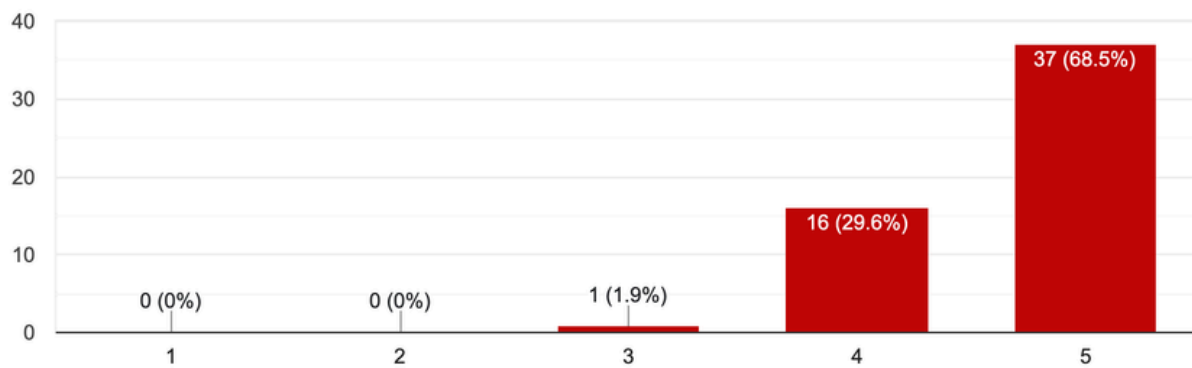
Were the training materials (slides, handouts, resources) helpful?

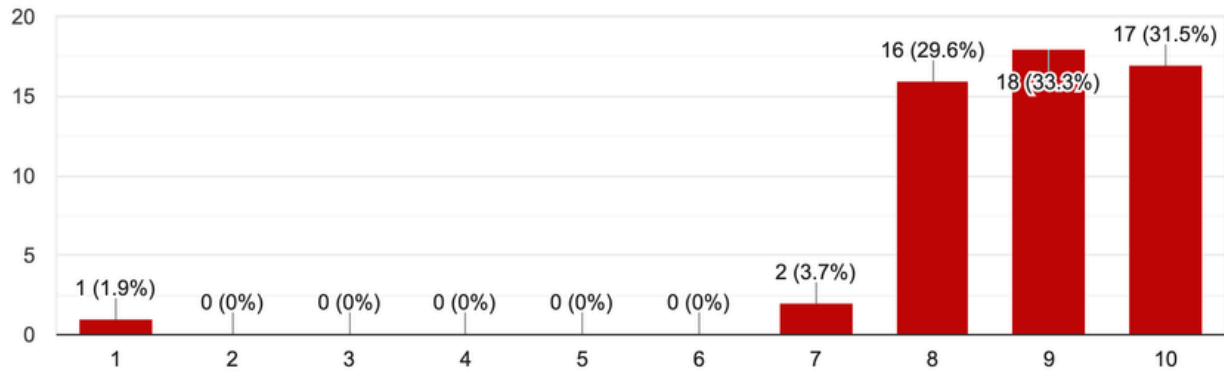
Was the training environment (venue/online setup) comfortable and effective?

INTERPRETATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP BOOTCAMP II EVALUATION DATA

The data provides valuable insights into the effectiveness of the Scholarship Bootcamp II program. Overall, the results show strong positive feedback, with a few areas that could be further improved. Below are the key interpretations:

1. High Relevance and Participant Satisfaction

The majority of participants rated the bootcamp content highly, with most responses concentrated in the top rating categories. Only a very small percentage selected lower ratings.

📌 Interpretation:

The program content was highly relevant to participants' needs. The bootcamp successfully met expectations and delivered meaningful value to the attendees.

2. Strong Trainer Knowledge and Delivery

Most participants gave high scores for the trainers' knowledge, clarity, and delivery. The ratings show that participants appreciated the expertise and preparation of the speakers.

However, a small portion of participants gave moderate ratings, which may suggest that engagement or interaction could be enhanced.

Interpretation:

The trainers were well-prepared and knowledgeable. To make future sessions even better, adding more interactive activities, discussions, or Q&A sessions could increase participant engagement.

3. Well-Structured Program and Useful Materials

The evaluation data indicates that the organization of the bootcamp and the training materials were positively received. Most ratings fall within the higher score range.

A small number of participants selected mid-level ratings, which suggests there is slight room for improvement.

Interpretation:

The program structure was clear and organized. Minor adjustments in time management, presentation design, or material accessibility may further improve participant experience.

4. Positive Learning Environment

The majority of participants felt comfortable with the overall training environment. Ratings show that participants generally had a good experience during the sessions.

A few moderate responses may reflect small logistical challenges such as venue arrangement, sound system, or seating.

Interpretation:

The learning environment was supportive and comfortable. Small improvements in logistics and technical setup could enhance future programs.

5. Increased Confidence in Scholarship Applications

The data shows that most participants reported higher confidence levels after attending the bootcamp. Many rated their confidence in the upper range.

Interpretation:

The bootcamp had a strong positive impact on participants' readiness to apply for scholarships. It successfully equipped them with practical knowledge, strategies, and motivation.

OUR SUCCESS AND FINAL CONCLUSION ON TRAINING EVALUATION

The evaluation results of the **Scholarship Bootcamp II** clearly show that the program was highly successful in achieving its objectives. Based on the data collected from participants, the following key points highlight our success:

High Completion Rate

Out of 80 participants, 79 successfully completed the bootcamp requirements. Only one participant did not finish the consultation session due to professional responsibilities and a tight schedule, not because of any issue related to the program itself.

This reflects a very strong commitment level from participants and demonstrates the effectiveness and relevance of the bootcamp.

High Participant Satisfaction

The majority of participants rated the overall training experience in the highest categories. Most responses were concentrated in ratings 4 and 5, with only a very small percentage selecting moderate or low scores.

This indicates that participants were satisfied with the program content, organization, and overall experience. The bootcamp effectively met their expectations and learning needs.

Strong Trainer Performance

The data shows very high ratings for trainer knowledge, clarity, and delivery. Participants recognized the expertise and preparation of the trainers.

Although a small percentage gave moderate ratings in engagement, overall feedback reflects strong appreciation for the trainers' guidance and support.

This confirms that the quality of facilitation was one of the key strengths of the bootcamp.

Effective Program Structure and Materials

Most participants rated the training materials and organization positively. The structure of the sessions helped participants clearly understand scholarship application processes, including essay writing and preparation strategies.

While a few participants suggested room for minor improvements, the overall feedback confirms that the bootcamp design was effective and well-organized.

Supportive Learning Environment

The evaluation also shows that participants generally felt comfortable in the learning environment. The atmosphere was supportive and encouraging, allowing participants to actively learn and build confidence.

Small logistical improvements may further enhance future programs, but overall satisfaction remains high.

Increased Confidence and Impact

One of the strongest indicators of success is the noticeable increase in participants' confidence levels. Most participants rated their confidence in applying for scholarships in the higher range after completing the bootcamp.

This demonstrates that the training successfully equipped students with practical knowledge, clear strategies, and motivation to pursue scholarship opportunities.

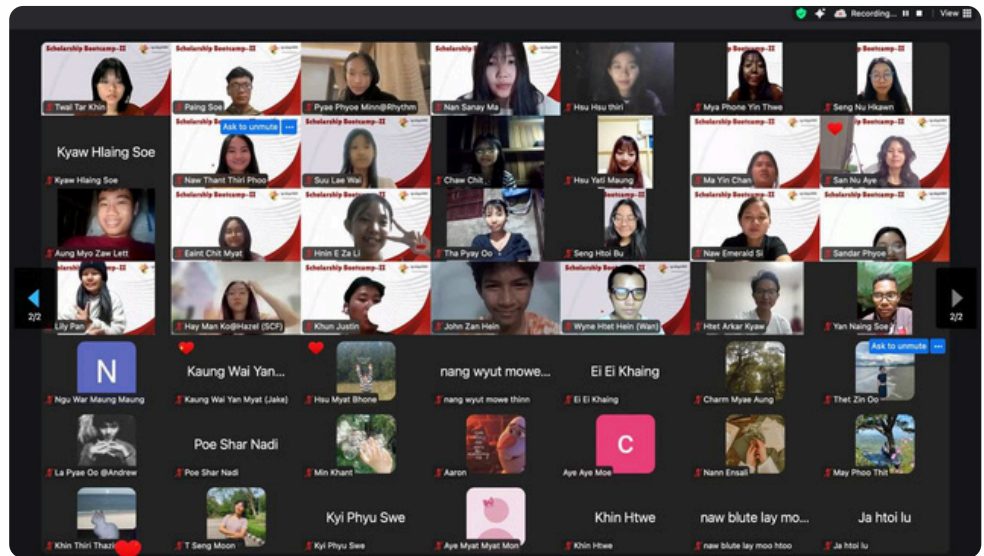

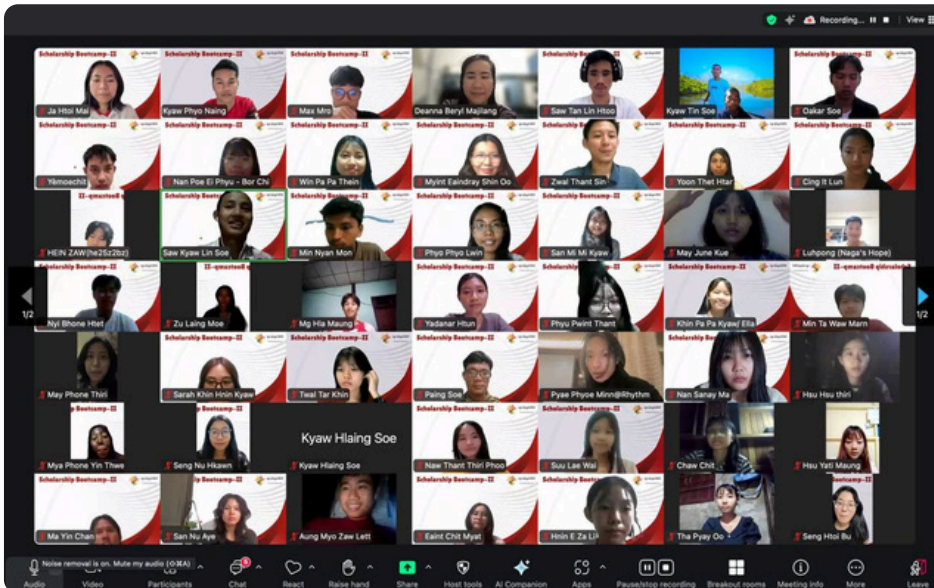
Future programs can build on this success by incorporating more interactive activities, offering follow-up mentorship support, and continuing to strengthen participant engagement.

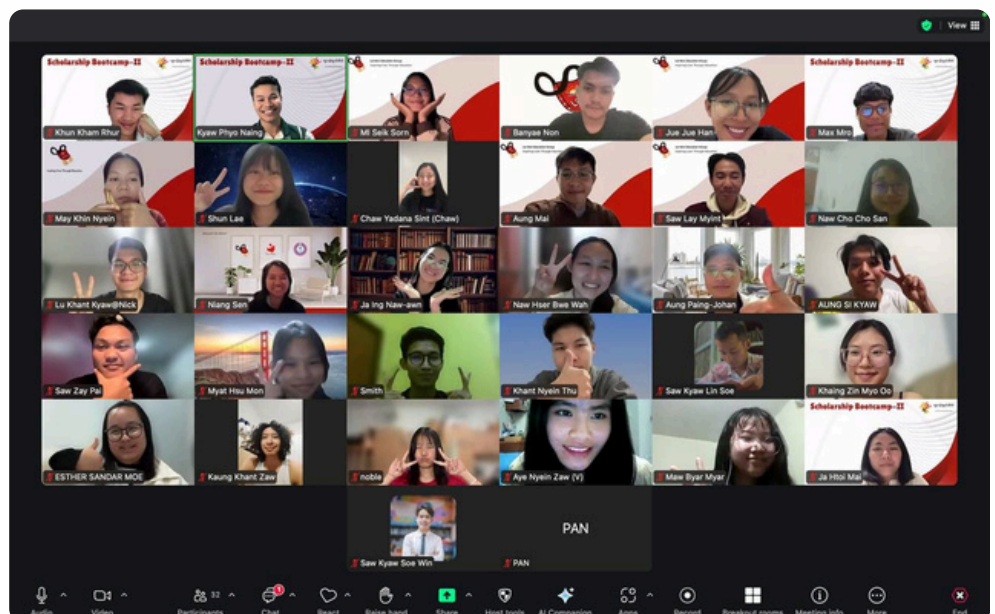
